Legislative Data

Data obtained under legislative requirement from third party provider.

from Financial Institutions



Special Purpose Acquisition Data

Acquired for specific purpose generally via Commissioner's Information Gathering powers

Section 353-10 powers (s 353-10 of Sch 1 to the Taxation Administration Act 1953)



Online Services for





The Business Portal is a **secure website** enabling businesses to manage tax affairs including:

- ▶ lodge various online forms
- prepare, lodge and revise activity statements
- ▶ view statements of account and find your payment reference number (PRN)
- ▶ view your Single Touch Payroll (STP) reports
- request a refund or transfer funds between accounts
- update your business registration details, including email addresses
- register for goods and services tax (GST) and pay as you go (PAYG) withholding
- ► test, lodge and download files



Online Services for Individuals myGov & Super



Provides an **online platform** for individuals and sole traders to:

- ▶ lodge tax return using myTax with Prefill data
- year to date STP (inc Super) data
- manage your PAYG instalments
- make a payment or create a payment plan
- manage superannuation employer contributions
- ▶ find super accounts held in a fund, and also those amounts held by us
- ▶ find lost and ATO-held super and consolidate your accounts



Standard Business Reporting (SBR)

Partnering with Digital Service Providers

Accessed by: Individuals, Non-Individuals, Intermediaries and super clients

Digital Service Providers can consume our wholesale services to build commercial accounting and Practice Management software:

- ▶ prepare & lodge selected electronic forms securely and in real time
- enables preparation of most common government forms directly from financial, accounting or payroll software
- receive fast confirmation that we have received your lodgement
- report through a single online channel.

Data Visibility - Minimum Viable Product



The Minimum Viable Product (MVP) is intended to improve the **Small Business client experience** by providing transparency of data the ATO holds. It will also extend the assurance currently provided to individuals through pre-fill data to small businesses.

This will make data more accessible, discoverable, and usable for clients, their representatives, our staff and partners.

MVP - Phase 1


- ✓ Facility will be made available to Small Business and their Authorised Intermediaries
- ✓ Accessible at any time current Pre-filled data is only available to individuals upon lodging Income Tax Return
- ✓ A direct Online service via ATO Online and provided as a wholesale service offering to Digital Service Providers
- ✓ Will include current year and prior years data where possible
- ✓ **Self-service** available to authenticated clients to access their information. Will provide the ability to notify/query incorrectly matched data, incomplete data or the source of data.

Datasets

- Taxable Payment Annual Report (TPAR) Payee Data: Payers must report if they
 have made payments to contractors for providing the following industry:
 - ✓ Building and construction services
 - Cleaning services for contractor payments from
 1 July 2018 (first report due by 28 August 2019)
 - courier services for contractor payments from
 July 2018 (first report due by 28 August 2019)
 - ✓ Transactions: 1.660.908 and SMB distinct clients: 714.244
- Taxable Government Grants and Payments (TGGP) Payee Data
 - ✓ Federal, state, territory and local government entities report to us the total payments they make to businesses each year.
 - Transactions: 110,990 and SMB distinct clients: 36,451
- Business Transactions through Payment Systems (BTTPS)
 - Merchant data providers (enabling business to take credit and debit card payments + EFTPOS):
 - ✓ Specialised payment systems data providers (focussed on alternatives to standard merchant facilities (like PayPal, Stripe, BPAY, recurring direct debits etc.)
 - ✓ Transactions: 806,839 and SMB distinct clients: 597,851




Timeline: Data Window – 2019 towards 2024





Digital Service Providers (DSPs) & Wholesale



Data Visibility aims to improve Wholesale & DSP client experience by providing transparency of data the ATO holds.

ATO is now making data it receives and holds available to clients directly and for Registered Agents.

It will aid in lodging Income and Activity Statements correctly, however, data is available anytime – not linked to lodgment calendar.

Channel & Data Options

Data to be provided via several channels:

- ✓ ATO Online for Individuals
- ✓ Online Services for Agents (OSFA) for Tax Agents
- ✓ Online Services for Business (OSB)
- New Standard Business Reporting (SBR) service

Data available for all entity types

(not only individuals in current IITR Pre-fill)

- Provide more BTTPS data (beyond the 40 provided in Pre-fill)
- ✓ TPAR and TGGP not restricted to SMB

Message Design

**Current Early Design - not Final and may change **

Input Request data

- ✓ Client Identifier (TFN / ABN)
- ✓ Income Type (TPAR, TGGP, BTTPS)
- ✓ Start + End date range (Max 1 year)

Other Options being considered

- ✓ Request all Types
- / Data ATO received since <date>

Response Data

- ✓ Payer Details, Taxation date, Amounts
- ✓ Multiple records not aggregated amounts
- ✓ Eg if Bank reports BTTPS data monthly, 12 records returned for Year
- ✓ Returns all matched data ATO holds
- Not Guaranteed to be all data a client needs for their return



Digital Service Providers (DSPs) & Wholesale



Data Visibility aims to improve **Wholesale & DSP client experience** by providing transparency of data the ATO holds.

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Message Technical Details

**Current Early Design - not Final and may change **

✓ Similar to Capital Gains Tax Transactions (CGTTX) – Shares & Units

Bulk & Batch Request Processor (BBRP) Only

- ✓ Potentially large amount of Data Returned
- ✓ Can call multiple times for larger Volumes (reduce date range)

Extensible Mark-up Language (XML)

- ✓ C# Validation Rules
- ✓ Response likely to use Key value pairs as in Copy of Return for ease of later extension

To be determined (TBD)

- ✓ Access Manager (AM) permissions
- ✓ May be a maximum number of records returned TBD from Perf Testing

Optional To Use

- ✓ Not Linked to Annual Tax Time (TT) rollovers
- ✓ No expectation the service would version up each year
- ✓ No explicit link to Tax Lodgment available any time
