Agenda item 4 - Update on general matters and Tax time delivery

The AS.2023 service, ASLRPT and On-demand lodgment list service are in EVTE, and testing can commence. The PROD release for AS.2023 is expected to be 30 January 2024.

There are some issues in PROD with ASLRPT, as well as ITCRPT with documentation and a small bug that require fixing.

The lodgment list service is live in PROD, but we are proposing to add an additional field to the service.

Details on issues with the services will be added to the Tax Time FAQ pages.

The On-demand reports (ASLRPT) working group will be reconvened in early February 2024.

Agenda item 5 – Delivery update

The December EVTE will include updates for DTA (double tax agreement) and other IDS change for OBU (Offshore Banking Units) – see latest ROAP (release on a page) for further details.

New labels for MTAS will be added and artefacts will be published next week.

There are issues with the lodgment list service where the AS (activity statement) form type is not included in the response. 2 options were presented to the group to resolve this issue:

1. Update the existing LDG.list 2023 service, or
2. A new lodgment list 2024 service

Based on responses from the group, option 1 was the preferred choice.

Platforms are performing as expected. There were some intermittent issues, a minor one on 22nd November, 23 November there were longer impacts. On 24th/25th November EVTE was affected, where messages couldn't get through due to firewall issues. These were restored on the 25th November.
