Agenda item 4 - Update on general matters and Tax time delivery

We are continuing to receive tickets pointing out differences with conformance suites, MST's, paper forms and PDF's. The group was asked to continue lodging tickets when discrepancies are noticed.

We will commence closing off the FBT tickets as the 2024 service is now in production. We will also update the product register.

Discussions are ongoing about the need to PVT for tax time products. We anticipate a decision by the end of May about whether PVT will need be required. It was clarified with the group that PVT may be required where there are significant changes to a product, in particular those related to MTAS.

Agenda item 5 – Delivery update

The EVTE release on the weekend of 18 May will contain:

- cyclical updates for IITR
- a number of changes to address questions and incidents relating to MTAS
- bug fixes such as the fix for incident INC004110409, and another where there are 7 options listed in the stakeholder pack and MST valid values, but only 6 listed in Full Enumeration with INC004110409.
- updates to the validation rules for IITR, NRFI and the IITR profile to remove occupation code descriptions.

The following conformance suites will be updated to rationalise and align testing data across common domains. These updates will allow DSPs to test scenarios related to services more effectively and ensure alignment with current standards:

- Self-Managed Super Funds Verify SMSFVRFY 2020
- Self-Managed Super Funds Member Verify <u>SMSFMBRVRFY 2020</u>

The updates will include revising identifiers (TFNs, ABNs) and respective demographic data including names, addresses, and dates of birth within the Conformance Suites and payloads.

We're also updating the following conformance suite:

Communication Preferences – <u>COMMPREF 2019</u>

The updates will include revising identifiers (TFNs, ABNs) and respective demographic data including names, addresses, and dates of birth within the Conformance Suites and payloads.

We welcome your feedback on the existing conformance suite scenarios for these services, available in <u>SBR</u> <u>ShareFile</u>. Specifically, we want to know if the scenarios are appropriate and, if they reflect real business flows. <u>Submit your feedback</u> in the DSP service desk by **22 May**.

Draft conformance suites are scheduled for publication in July, with payload updates planned for October.
