Agenda item 1 - Welcome

Agenda item 7 - Agent online environment update

No issues to report in the Agent online environment, other than the degradation that occurred overnight on 7 October, and was resolved early 8 October.

The DPO are working directly with the Pre-fill team about the OSfA pre-fill software specification (Pre-filling report 2024) to import pre-filling data into tax agent software. The draft spec is anticipated shortly, with only a minor display change - TSL (Trade Support Loan) will change to AASL (Australian Apprenticeship Support Loan). Once available, the OSfA pre-fill software spec will be published to the DSP Hub and included in the DSP newsletter.

Agenda item 8 - DSP communications update

The group were reminded the draft XML specifications (MST and schema) for the 2025 Partnership tax return (PTR) are available for review on the XBRL to XML Conversion Supporting Information page in the DSP hub for review and feedback by 14 October.

The IITR Profile Compare Business Implementation Guide (BIG) IITRPRFL.0006 2024 was published on the SBR website on 26 September 2024 and includes an additional response message for trust distributions.

The SBR service desk phone number will be decommissioned on 18 October due to reduced demand. The afterhours contact number will remain available.
