Agenda item 3 – Tax time related documentation

Change advice [CA2025-017 ‘Building Australia’s Future – A fairer deal for students’](#) was published in the DSP hub on 20 August.

In November 2024 the government announced the “Making HELP and student loan repayments fairer” measure. The *Universities Accord (Cutting Student Debt by 20 Per Cent) Act 2025* received Royal Assent on Saturday 2 August 2025. The Act commenced on Monday 3rd August 2025 the day after Royal Assent.

The Act contains two measures:

1. The first requires no DSP action: to apply a 20% reduction to all Study and Training Support Loan (STSL) account debts as at 1 June 2025, and
2. The second will have a direct impact on DSPs: the introduction of a marginal repayment system for the calculation of study and training loan repayments.

The outstanding tax time tickets where validation rules were being queried are being investigated.

The PIITR business implementation guide (BIG) will soon be published on sbr.gov.au once confirmed with business.

DSPs were thanked for providing requested information regarding AS2025 tickets.

Agenda item 5 – Delivery update

GloBE Information Rules (GIR):

- As stated during the walkthrough of the roadmap at the last PLS working group meeting, the GIR updates were scheduled for September EVTE. This has shifted a month and will now be available in October EVTE (17 October 2025) and will be reflected shortly in the latest roadmap.

Outcome of Assessment (ASMT):

- Incident fix for ASMT146 'Sum of shortfall amounts', so that it will return a value in all circumstances where applicable from 2018 financial years onwards. This has no code or artefact impacts but is called out in the PCN.
- To be deployed into EVTE as a part of our September EVTE release (19 September 2025) and into production as a part of our November Production release (14 November 2025).
- This will be reflected in the latest roadmap when it is next published in the next month.

Modernisation of Tax Administration Systems (MTAS) Phase 2:

- The latest schema and label changes have been published onto the DSP hub for the Trust Tax Return (TRT) service. Validation rules are being worked on and will be provided soon

September EVTE deployment and publications:

- We will provide an overview at the next PLS working group meeting of the upcoming changes planned to be deployed.
