## Agenda item 1 – Welcome

The chair opened the meeting and welcomed the group.

The group was advised that a review of the current change advice template is underway to ensure it remains useful for DSPs. Feedback is welcome and the topic will be revisited at the next PLSWG meeting.

Reponses to the follow up items from the previous meeting were provided:

- DSP query regarding the ETA of the Pre-fill BIG and whether the TPAR pre-fill will be added into the legacy XML pre-fill
  - the pre-fill BIG isn't available, the draft is expected by the end of March, final publication anticipated in April
  - there may be a delay on the DVA/ other codes being shared from other agencies this year
  - the requirements when prefilled TPAR information is adjusted and how this should be approached, has been escalated to the business area and further advice will be provided once available.
- The draft Trust Tax Return referred publication is being prioritised for review and will be published to the DSP Hub as soon as possible.

There are two corrections for the March EVTE release:

EXTERNAL



- Incorrectly called out FVS deployment to EVTE in March. There are no further FVS changes and last version published in February is final.
- Annual Investment Income Report (AIIR) will now be deployed into EVTE for April EVTE instead of March EVTE.

## Agenda item 6 – Agent online environment update

A small number of registered agent numbers were not recognised by the IVR system when agents attempted to reach ATO call centres. This was resolved on 3 March.

Pre-fill BIG – Business owners are currently reviewing the TPAR mapping and BIG content.

OSFA – Account SPA's returning overdue amount when the due date had not yet passed. There were no reports in relation to SBR. This is under investigation.

March release is scheduled for 13-15 March 2026. Internal and external (with an agent) business deployment verification will be undertaken for any OSFA changes.

## Agenda item 8 – Platform update

At the previous meeting a DSP reported higher latency between the LDG.list service in SBR2 and the AS list service in SBR1. The following response was provided:

- SBR2 services in SRP (AS list and LDG.list) have an average response time of 1.9 – 2.3 seconds whereas the AS list in SBR1 averages between 500-700ms
- This is due to the different system architectures and utilisation. It is expected behaviour for SBR2 services response time to be in this range.
- Both remain within expected response-time ranges, and no further investigation is planned.

A separate query has been received about response-time variations in SBR1 AS services. This appears to be a different issue and is still under investigation, with updates to follow once more information is available.

The MEIG upgrade is proceeding in production and is scheduled for the weekend of 14 March.
