**OUTCOMES:**

Participants clarified goals, expectations, and next steps.

## 1. Understand the background to the issue and the desires of DSPs and of ATO.

Participants discussed and had consensus on the background, that:

“This focus group was called by the Single Touch Payroll Technical Committee (STPTC) in the meeting of [5 December 2018](#) in response to digital service providers (DSPs) concerns<sup>(1)</sup> that the data structures differed between the tax file number declaration (TFND), the TFND part of Payroll Event (PAYEVNT), the online tax file number declaration screen, the Bulk Data Exchange (BDE) and the paper form.

Note (1) A document [TFNDEC vs PAYEVNT comparisons\(XLS\)](#), had been tabled at the STPTC meeting [21 Nov 2018](#).

## 2. Establish agreed understanding of the expectations and goals of the group.

Participants agreed that:

**The GOALS are:**

1. Immediate goal: To identify irritants that can be addressed immediately for the data elements of the TFND and/or PAYEVNT web services
2. Extended goal: To document a recommendation to the STPTC on:
  - confirming the future need for a separate TFND rather than incorporating within PAYEVNT
  - the potential (of ATO and the software industry) to align the data collected in the TFNDEC form with the TFND and PAYEVNT services
  - impacts, risks, benefits of implementing changes and of not implementing changes

**The EXPECTATION** is that outcomes of the group’s activities will be a collective and representative recommendation to ATO’s architectural program of work, and will not imply commitment by ATO to implement changes.

## 3. Understand what is in scope or out of scope

Participants identified

**out-of-scope as**

- Systemic causes of differences ( i.e. focused on tactical fix)
- data structure mis-alignment of other services

#### 4. Identify if there are other key people that may be needed

Participants identified the need for

ATO to invite DSPs from other software market sectors like (Tax Practitioner; HR)

All participants were urged to inform Michael Connolly or Gary Anderson, if they subsequently thought of anyone else.

#### 5. TIME-FRAME

For goal 1 : the short term irritants: ATO noted that there may be a window of opportunity to influence TFNDEC ver 5 due July 2019 with short term changes.

The window to include changes ends mid to late January 2019, but this group will next meet on 16 January 2019

For goal 2: The longer view of alignment: The group expressed interest in meeting for a half day instead of only 90 minutes on 16th January 2019 (by telepresence or face-to-face if possible)

#### 6. NEXT STEPS

a) ATO to develop appropriate agenda and confirm logistics for possible half day workshop on 16<sup>th</sup> to include the long-term goals

POST-SCRIPT: The 90 minute webex meeting was extended to a half day by telepresence on 19<sup>th</sup> December, 2019

b) Participants noted that the following information would be useful for a workshop on the long term goals.

The focus group will need to understand:

- ATO plans for deprecation of versions of TFND services (ATO)
- Confirmation of continuation of TFND services separately to PAYEVNT (ATO)
- Stats on usage of TFND (ATO)
- ATO plans for paper forms version of TFNDEC (ATO)
- External impacts on the sw industry and users (DSPs)
