



Change Summary

Contributions MIG v2.0 includes new government-funds interactions, i.e. government contributions, government contributions amendment, and associated error / outcome responses. New taxonomies and Service / Action values will be used for these new interactions.

Existing employer-fund interactions (B2B), i.e. member registrations and contributions, will continue to use the same taxonomies and Service / Action values, as per industry's current implementation. However Response Messaging Framework a few guidance notes has been incorporated in Contributions v2.0 for B2B interactions (reflected in Schedule 4a, Schedule 6, and the Contributions User guide v2.0).

The following SuperStream schedules are re-published on 20 April 2017 based on industry feedback.

- Schedule 4a – Contributions Message Implementation Guide (MIG) v2.0
- Schedule 5 – Message Orchestration and Profiles v2.0
- Schedule 6 – Error Code Management v2.0

The purpose of this release is to provide further clarification on the scope of changes required for Contributions v2.0 implementation. This release only includes minor wording changes and is not expected to impact industry's implementation.

Details of changes are listed below.

Schedule 4a

- Correction

Section 2.1 (page 10) – Interaction Diagram

Government Contribution Transaction Amendment Outcome Response is a mandatory response thus should have a solid line in the diagram.

Section 6.2 (page 46) – Message Transport Linkage Table, “ElectronicErrorMessaging” Property: “If this attribute is not included, this indicates that the sender is not capable of handling the receipt of electronic Member Registration Outcome Response messages.” Changed to “Contributions Transaction Error Response”.

- Clarification

Section 7 (page 64) – Contributions Transaction Error Response, Explanatory Notes
Included additional sentence to be consistent with Government Contributions Transaction Error Response:

“This message can also be used by superannuation funds to refund a payment for one or more members within a CTR message which could not be processed.”

Section 4.3 (page 27) – Member Registration Request (MRR)

Section 6.4 (page 48) – Contributions Transaction Request (CTR)

Section 8.4 (page 74)– Government Contribution Transaction Request (GCTR)

Section 10.3 (page 96) – Government Contribution Transaction Amendment Request (GCTAR)

Include corresponding taxonomy version for each of the above request message.

Section 12 (page 108) – Alternative Arrangements, Explanatory Notes

Corrected section number, should be “12.2.1.” rather than “8.2.1”.

Schedule 5

- Clarification

Section 2.2.4 (page 7) – table of ‘href’ values

Clarified the href values refer to corresponding taxonomy versions, rather than MIG versions.

Additional notes included for clarification.

Background

Contributions taxonomy v2.0 was designed to cater for both B2B and G2B contributions so that the two interactions use the same pattern / payload.

However under Contributions MIG v2.0, B2B contributions continue to use current payload (i.e. taxonomy v1.0) due to STP uncertainties.

- Government Contributions Amendment Outcome Response (GCTAOR)
- Rollover Transaction Outcome Response (RTOR)
- USM Rollover Transaction Outcome Response (USM RTOR)
