Summary

The participants in the workshop:

- found definite value in exploring the common errors
- would like to see information presented via industry type or lodgment channel as it is important to know who is making the errors
- agreed they wanted the ATO to use existing multiple channels to communicate and share the errors such as SIPO, Tax Agent Newsletter and Let's Talk
- suggested that the timeliness of communication is important as the information needs to be current and updated real time as issues arise
- made some early suggestions to prevent common errors, including:
 - a reason code be allowed against BAS labels to explain particular entries
 - a search engine in the software on known errors could be handy
 - perhaps software could be linked into the ABN lookup tool to automate some fields

The ATO will:

- explore ways to refine the errors
- collate and share the common errors via the most appropriate means (eg SWD homepage to store common errors and alert via SWD newsletter, Tax Agent Newsletter)
- consider preparing a common errors handbook
